## **CD and DVD Recycling**

- **We will take all types of unwanted CD and DVD**
- **We will collect them on one day in March and one in September**
- **Just place the CDs and DVDs in a bag and place the bag in your large box**
- **Refer to your Recycling Collection Day Calendar for applicable dates**
- **Give quality re-saleable CDs and DVDs to charity**

Some questions you might have:

### ***What CDs and DVDs will you collect and what will you do with them?***

We will collect music CDs, video DVDs, computer program CDs and DVDs, any free CDs and DVDs that come with newspapers and magazines, and any others you no longer want and which have little or no re-use or re-sale value. Any CDs and DVDs we collect are strictly for recycling: they will be passed on for granulation and reprocessing before being used in injection moulding manufacturing. We will not sort the CDs and DVDs and none will be re-used. If you have quality re-saleable CDs and DVDs please put them in your white plastic Traid textile bag or give them to charity shops. Do not give free music and computer CDs and DVDs from newspapers and magazines to Traid or charity shops as these are non-resalable and most are thrown away. Recycle this kind of CD and DVD with us.

### ***When are the collections?***

It is important to collect the CDs and DVDs without unnecessary sorting and handling so they will be collected periodically and *not every fortnightly recycling collection*. We will collect CDs and DVDs from you **on one collection in March and one in September** and only on those days. Please check your 2010 Recycling Collection Calendar to see which dates are applicable to you, **as indicated by the letters 'CD' in place of the date**. You can also view your collection dates on our website (address above): just follow the links to your address and view the relevant calendar. Alternatively, if you know what day of the week your recycling is collected then whenever your collection falls between Monday 15<sup>th</sup> March and Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March and then Monday 13<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> September 2010 will be the applicable two collections for you.

### ***What do I need to do?***

Collect unwanted CDs and DVDs and on the designated day put them out for us in a bag (or tied together through the middle) and put them in your large box for plastic bottles, tin cans, and tin foil. Ensure the contents cannot spill but do not tie the bag tightly. We will return the bag to you for future re-use. Do not place CDs and DVDs loose in the box.

### ***What won't you take?***

We will only take the CD or DVD itself. Do not give us any packaging. We cannot recycle the standard plastic 'jewel' cases, plastic slip-cases and sleeves, cardboard sleeves, paper liner notes etc. It doesn't matter about stickers and print on the CDs themselves. We regret that any batch put out for us that contains packaging will be rejected in its entirety and left in your box.
